



INSTRUCTIONS FOR BFC QIH DESIGNS

These are general instructions for our designs that have 3 basting lines at the beginning and one basting line as the next to the last color.

EMBROIDER YOUR DESIGNS

Each design has three basting color stops at the beginning of the Design – Basting 1 (shown in Red), Basting 2 (shown in Blue) and Tack Down (shown in green.).

Please note: if you are using Angelina, you can overlap the edges slightly and press under a Teflon pressing cloth for 2 or 3 seconds to fuse them to make wider sections. It doesn't matter if it looks crinkly or wrinkled at all – that just makes it more sparkly.

This method allows you to use a small patch of fabric or add something like Angelina film to add sparkle Just hoop your stabilizer.

1. Hoop your stabilizer and stitch Basting 1
2. Remove Hoop from machine and place a piece of fabric or Angelina large enough to cover the stitching on top. Secure with tape, temporary adhesive spray or a little fabric glue stick. Return Hoop to machine.
3. Stitch Basting 2. Remove hoop from machine and trim the fabric as close as possible to the stitching line. Angelina will mostly pull away. Return to machine.
4. Stitch the next color stop – the Tack down – and the remainder of the design.
5. If desired, stop before the last Color Stop. Remove the hoop from the machine and place a layer of batting and backing fabric over the back of the design. Tape in place and return hoop. Stitch the Basting line and then the Satin stitch Border..
6. Remove from Hoop and tear or cut away the stabilizer around the design.

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
